What we have been learning about this week in school:

This week we have been writing our innovated stories and the children have made a great effort to include all of the things that we have been learning about in Literacy this term. We have learnt how to find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of shapes and numbers.

What we will be doing next term in school:

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We hope you understand that our first priority is always the health and safety of your children.

We have been very concerned about the strong smell of cannabis around and just outside of our school site at the beginning and end of the school day.

We have had complaints from many parents about this too.

Passive smoking has a huge impact on the development and well-being of children. It has long been known that when children are around adults who smoke tobacco they are more likely to suffer from ear infections, if they suffer from asthma it is far worse and it can lead to higher incidences of cot death.

Research into the effects of passive smoking cannabis is on-going but studies have found that the cannabis is absorbed into the bloodstream of children who are with adults smoking cannabis.

This has an impact on a child's memory, their ability to concentrate, their ability to organise their thoughts and their behaviour.

Please can you help us keep your children safe and well by not smoking tobacco or cannabis near our school.
