Apple Class

This week in Reception, we have been talking about Pandas and making a habitat for them.

Due to our forest school area being flooded we made indoors, mores and showed we can follow instructions and be safe with an open flame. We read the story 'Please Mr Panda' and made our own doughnuts using brown paper, paint, and coloured beads for sprinkles
