	Learning Objective	Suggested Activities
Life Skills/ PSHE	We are thinking of all of the things that we are thankful for	Listen to the story 'I'm thankful each day' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JlodsXEvo4U Talk to your family about some things that you are thankful for. Ask them to share their ideas with you too.
Literacy	We are going to be writing about what happened to Marmalade the bear on our trip to the High Street last week. We will be using time connectives.	The adventures of Marmalade the bear. Tell your grown-ups about our trip to the High Street last week. What happened? Where did we see Marmalade? What happened to him? What was the first thing we did? The last? Try to use the words first, next, then and finally to order your story. Ask a grown up to help you have a go at writing some simple sentences using some time connectives. Remember to use a capital letter at the beginning of your sentence and a full stop at the end. You could draw some pictures to illustrate your story.
Phonics	Phase 3 phonics To be able to read and write words with 'oo'(long vowel sound) and 'ar' sounds.
