### Oak & Willow Class

We have had another lovely week in Year One and the children have worked really hard writing the story of The 3 Little Pigs in Literacy. In Maths, we have been learning about subtraction and how to read and record take away number sentences.

The children have really impressed us with their fantastic model houses in Design and Technology.

Next week we are going to start thinking about Christmas which is very exciting! We will be thinking about the Christmas story in Literacy and starting our Christmas Art activities. In Maths, the children will be solving simple word problems using subtraction and in Music we are learning Christmas songs.

### Birch & Lime Class

This week we have continued writing our own version of the story 'The Bear and the Piano' and we have been learning to edit our own work.

In Maths, we have been recognising coins and ordering them by value. We have created our own forest boxes this week based on the book setting.

We have been learning about living things and their habitats.



Next week we will be predicting what might happen next after the Bear returned to the forest. We will be writing about what we think may happen. In Maths, we will be making different amounts and combinations of money. In science and geography, we will be comparing different habitats and creating artwork to show our understanding.



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### Nursery News Acorns



In Acorns we have been making a large circle collage using 2D and 3D materials. The children have also been experimenting with free printing.

We have made lots of different constructions using a variety of different building materials.



The children have also been sorting big and little objects e.g. a big and little spoon, big plate little plate.

### Conkers

This week the children have continued to listen to the story "The Three Little Pigs". They are able to retell the story in their own words, and at circle time act out the story.

We have supported the children's physical development, by practising their climbing, jumping, balancing skills on the obstacle course, and throwing, kicking and catching a large ball.

They have enjoyed playing with the doctors role play, this encouraged children to play, interact together and extend role plays and talk about their experiences.
