


	Learning Objective	Suggested Activities
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>To be able to label a picture of a house, listening to the sounds in words and recording them in the sequence I hear them.</p> 	<p>Can you draw a picture of your house? What rooms are in it? Can you label the rooms and items in your house?</p> <p>Say the word for the part of the house, listen for the sounds in the words and write the sounds you hear in sequence. There's a sound mat at the bottom of this document to help you know what the sound look like.</p>
<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>Phase 2: recall sounds To segment and blend sound in words to read CVC words.</p>	<p>Can you sing the phonics song and recall all the sounds we have learnt? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sAF3-fOXWAY</p> <p>We are looking at the v, x, y and w sounds this week. Can you watch the videos about these sounds? 

<p>Maths</p> 	<p>To be able to recognise 2D shapes. To create a picture using 2D shapes.</p>	<p>Watch this song about some 2D shapes: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RRiWpCfp75g</p> <p>Look at the shapes at the bottom of the page. Can you recognise and name them? How did you know they were that shape? How many corners do they have? How many Sides?</p> <p>Can you go on a shape hunt around your house? What shapes can you find? E.g. the clock is a circle.</p>
<p>UTW</p> 	<p>To understand that I live in Stonehouse and Stonehouse is in England, Great Britain.</p>	<p>To use Google Earth to look at England on the Globe: www.google.co.uk/intl/en_uk/earth/</p> <p>Can you find England on the globe? This is where we live. Can you now find Stonehouse? This is in the South West of England. Can you see your house? What other things in Stonehouse can you see? E.g. the War memorial, the post office, shops etc.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<p>To move items with increasing control. To be able to throw items using an underarm throw, with increasing control.</p> 	<p>Can you go into the garden to practise your under arm throw? Put something on the ground (like a hoop) as your target. For an under arm throw there are some steps to success that you need to follow:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Face target 2- Step forward with opposite leg 3- Swing arm back and then forward 4- Release ball when are pointing at target. <p>Once you have perfected this, see if you can throw it to some one in your house. Get them to cup their hands in front of them as the target.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts Development</p>	<p>To listen to a piece of music and respond to how it makes you feel.</p>	<p>To listen to Our House by Madness. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2fy9_Hx_wlY</p> <p>Listen to it once all the way through. Then repeat the song and on a piece of paper draw how it makes you feel and what it makes you think of. Is it happy? Is it Sad? What colour does it make you want to draw in? Why?</p>
<p>Forest School</p> 	<p>To build with a purpose in mind. To be able to build a house from junk modelling.</p> 	<p>Listen and watch the story After the Storm by Nick Butterworth. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OfPj5_k2kZk</p> <p>Can you build Percy a new home? Have a look in your recycling bin. Are there some good boxes and containers that could make a house for Percy? Can you go into the garden and find some natural items to decorate the house so it would fit in, in the park? You could put sticks on the roof, or leaves on the walls.</p>



<p>Communication and Language</p>	<p>To be able to listen carefully and remember items said.</p>	<p><u>I Went to the Shops...</u></p> <p>This is a great game to challenge for your listening and memory skills.</p> <p>One person starts off the shopping list by saying "I went to the shops today and bought..." something. The next person continues by saying the previous item and adding their own item.</p> <p>Keep going until someone makes a mistake!!</p>
<p>Please continue to practice the children's independence skills e.g. putting shoes and coats on independently. To continue to read home reading book and other stories at home.</p>		


My Phase 2 Sound Mat






