


<p>Maths</p>	<p>We are learning to subtract using the part whole model.</p>	<p>We are practising subtraction using objects and learning about the part-whole model (this will help us see subtraction as the inverse of addition e.g. <math>2 + 8 = 10</math> and <math>10 - 8 = 2</math> ) This is what a part-whole model looks like.</p>  <p>There is a fantastic BBC Bitesize home learning lesson that looks at subtraction and the part-whole method for Year 1.
