What 2D shapes can you find? Use the 2D shape mat in your pack to help.</p> <p>Can you cut out some 2D shapes from paper? Can you make your own picture using the 2D shapes? It could be a house or a rocket or anything you wish to make!</p>	<p><b>To talk about shape properties.</b>          Today we are going to look at 2D shapes again. <p>UTW</p> 	<p><b>To talk about the features of their own immediate environment and how environments might vary from one another. Where is it? How do we get there? What's there when you get there?</p>				

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	<p>Can you make a picture of what space might look like? If you're in the picture, how will you have travelled there and what might you have to wear?</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<p><b>To be able to handle tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control.</b></p> <p>Cook some spaghetti with help from an adult. Let the spaghetti cool down.</p>  <p>Now can you use the scissors to cut the spaghetti. Hold the scissors correctly with the thumb in the top hole of the scissors.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts Development</p>	<p><b>To construct with a purpose in mind, using a variety of resources.</b> <b>To design and create my own space rocket.</b></p> <p>Can you design your own rocket? Can you draw a picture of it? Label the parts of the rocket, recording the sounds you hear in sequence.</p> <p>Can you now build it? You could use boxes from the recycling or lego bricks. Use what ever you like to make your rocket.</p>
<p>Forest School</p> 	<p><b>To create a bird feeder for the garden.</b> <b>To construct with a purpose in mind.</b></p>  <p>Now it is winter it is harder for birds to find food. Can you make them a bird feeder for the garden? You need some string/pipe cleaner/ribbon and some cheerios. Can you thread the cheerios onto the string and then tie it together in a loop? Can you then hang it on a tree outside for the birds?</p> <p>Keep an eye on it and see if you see any birds coming to eat the food from the bird feeder!</p>
<p>Communication and Language</p>	<p><b>To learn and recall a familiar song.</b> <b>To think of actions for that song.</b></p>

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To practice the song 5 little men in a flying saucer.

Can you learn the words and create your own actions for this song.
