Next week we are going to be writing character descriptions, thinking carefully about using interesting adjectives.

In Maths we will be exploring multiplication and learning how to record our workings.

We are looking forward to learning about Berkeley castle in History and seeing how the beans that we planted have grown in Forest School.

We have been practising to become more independent with our learning and practical tasks. In Writing we have been thinking of some interesting adjectives to describe the dragons in the book and making changes to the text. We have learned about the UK and identified the countries and capital cities within it. We have continued to study the Artist Paul Klee and we have created our own artwork based on 'Castle and Sun'.

Next week, we will be planning to write our description about our very own dragons! We will be painting our dragons to create a picture in our mind of what our dragon is like and where they might be. In maths we will be practising to use a written method to subtract, including crossing ten.

Children have been encouraged to put on their own coats and are now spooning their own cereal into their own bowl and pouring on their own milk and their own drinks.

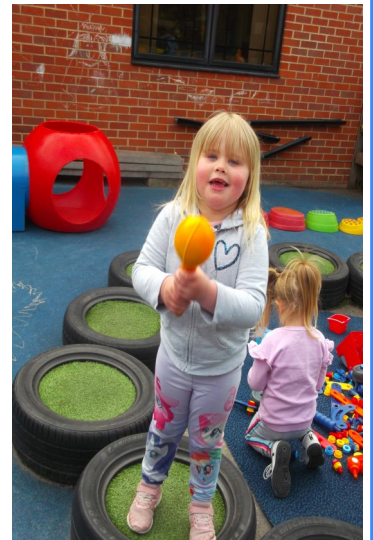


Conkers
