We've been looking at all the Autumnal changes that have happened over half term. We could feel that it was MUCH colder out at forest school this week! Next week we are going to be comparing numbers and counting forwards and backwards. Additionally, we will be continuing to read and explore Room on a Broom, sequencing the story and talking about the beginning, middle and end of the story.

Birch, Maple & Walnut Class

We have been busy looking at our new key text called 'After the Fall' by Dan Santat.

We have been making predictions about what might happen from looking at the outside of the book, talking about the story and thinking about the main character.



In Maths we have been adding two numbers using a range of resources and written methods.

We have been talking about why it is important to always tell the truth in PSHE and talked about the story the boy who cried wolf. We have also been exploring the Festival of Light, Diwali, and have made Rangoli patterns.

Next week we will be learning the story 'After the Fall' off by heart. We will learn the words and create actions to help us to recall it. In Maths, we will continue practising to add two numbers and continue problem solving.

We will be exploring activities to help us learn about Remembrance Day.



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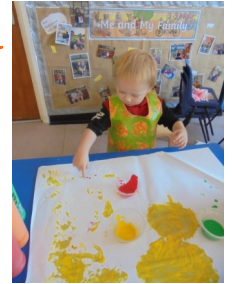


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Acorns
