Birch, Maple & Walnut Class

This week we have been writing about what happens in the beginning of the story 'After the Fall' and we have focused on using connecting words to extend our sentences.

In Maths, we have been looking at subtraction and have learned to use a written method to find the answer to the subtraction number sentences. We have started to apply our understanding to word problems. We have been thinking about where we live and looking at human and physical geographical features.

We have had some really interesting conversations!

In Science, Year 1 have continued to look at classifying animals while Year 2 have been learning to understand whether things are living, non-living or never have been alive.

Next week we will be writing about the middle and end of the story 'After the Fall'. In Maths, we will be applying our understanding of addition and subtraction and learn to select the correct method when answering both addition and subtraction number sentences.

In Science, Year 1 will be looking at what different animals eat and Year 2 will be learning about different habitats.

In guided reading, we will continue to learn about fiction & non-fiction books, the features and talk about our opinions!
